



GRAN RESERVA 2005 BODEGAS MARTÍNEZ ALESANCO

- Extra long oak ageing.
- Winery: Pedro Martínez Alesanco.
- Varieties: 90% Tempranillo and 10% Garnacha from our own vineyards in Badarán.
- Alcohol Content: 13,5 %Vol.
- Vinification process: Made from Tempranillo and Garnacha grapes, selected from low yielding vines which are over 50 years old. Aged for 36 months in new American and French oak barrels, where malolactic fermentation took place.
- Tasting:
 - o Look: Garnet red, intense, with a deep robe.
 - o Aroma: Huge complex aromas, very ripe red berries wrapped in some fine roasted aromas.
 - o Taste: A fresh entry, a rich wine thanks to the hints of cocoa and vanilla resulting from the time in the barrel. Long aftertaste that leaves the palate imbued with a complex range of flavors that invite you to drink.
- Consumption Temperature: 17/19°C
